

Grampound Road KS2 Results 2013/2014

End of KS1:

The expected standard at the end of KS1 is level 2. Ideally we aim for level 2b as this makes it more likely they will get to level 4 at the end of KS2. For the 2013/14 cohort, at the end of KS1 our results were as follows:

Writing	100% Roseland School Group = 89% National =85%	83.3%	35.3% Roseland School Group = 23% National =15%
Maths	92.6% Roseland School Group = 93% National =91%	88.8%	23.5% Roseland School Group = 24% National =23%

This shows we have improved in all areas for level 2+.

We have increased our percentage level 3s in writing yet there has been a decrease in reading and maths. These are in line with national except for reading.
