During his visit, Mr Rickett will join us for Collective Worship, observe RE lessons, talk to children, governors and parents. The school will be judged in four areas:

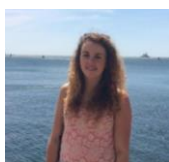
- **How well does the school, through its distinctive Christian character, meet the needs of all learners?**
