Homework is set weekly. Fell like school is run like a business and worry about losing its individuality. Children are at the heart of all of what we do. Wish meetings were not in school time – some parents work. We offer parents meetings/forums during school time and after hours. Parents of Reception children should have more than one parents evening to track thei child's progress. Reception teacher holds focus pupils meeting in addition to these and you can request additional meetings too. School menu odd – should be more input from children. Menu is created by catering company ensuring we meet all food standards meaning there is appropriate amount of sugar, salt and a balanced weekly menu. Why finish at lunch time on last day it causes a lot of disruption for parents. This is only at the end of a term and will be reflected upon
