Travel to Bishop Bronescombe on Monday 19th June 2017

We have reviewed the travel arrangements and amount of time the children will need to spend on the coach. After much consideration, we have arranged for two mini buses to pick up the children operating a shuttle system rather than the coach travelling to each school.

Please see details below of departure times.

The coach will leave Bishop Bronescombe at 11:00 am

Our expected arrival time on Friday 24th is at 3.15pm. The children will again be shuttled back to their schools.

Belongings should be packed in a named case or bag, which will remain on the coach and only be taken off at our accommodation. Please also supply your child with a packed lunch and drink for the outbound journey this should be in a small day bag. All children need to be able to identify their own luggage. Please also ensure that your child is able to carry their own luggage or that they have a small wheeled suitcase/holdall that they can pull along. They may need to carry their luggage upstairs so please ensure it is not too heavy! All luggage, clothing and personal possessions should be clearly labelled with your child's name. Thank you.

If you are happy for your child to bring a Nintendo DS, PSP and/or Ipod/mp3 player etc. and you feel your child will be responsible for them, then we are happy for the children to use these during the stay. They can help to provide the children with some entertainment for the journey. The children can ask any of the staff to lock them in their rooms during the night. Staff cannot take responsibility for the loss or damage of items. If your child brings any of these items, it has to be at their own risk. Insurance is provided by PGL insurance. Please remember that children are not to bring mobile phones. Past experience has shown that the children will text or phone at the first sign of any worries. You will be almost a hundred miles away and unable to do anything to help. The staff, on the other hand, will know all the background of any worries your child may have and we are used to dealing with them. We feel this would be the best course of action for both parent and child.
