

## Homework: Choices

Each term your English homework is broken into two parts. During the first half of each term, you will be given a choices sheet (this sheet) which you must complete before the half term holiday. Each week you must choose one written task, handing your completed work in by each Wednesday. What task will you choose first?

<p><u>Task 1: Slime (or something artistic)</u></p> <p>Everyone loves slime! Your task, should you choose to accept it, is to write a set of instructions on how to make the perfect slime. You may include numbered steps and photographs.</p>	<p><u>Task 2: Gymnastics / Dancing (or any sport)</u></p> <p>Recount Text. When was the last time you took part in gym or dance? Did you enjoy yourself? Your task is to write a recount of that experience. Let me know how you felt.</p>
<p><u>Task 3: Maths (or any subject)</u></p> <p>Persuasive Text. Do you have a subject you really love? Your task is to write a persuasive speech to convince another child, your age, to fall in love with your favourite subject.</p>	<p><u>Task 4: Minecraft</u></p> <p>Discussion Text. Should children be allowed to play Minecraft? Your mission is to write the good points and (yes!) the bad points about Minecraft. Add your opinion at the end.</p>
<p><u>Task 5: Lego Movie (or any movie).</u></p> <p>Letter. Another Lego movie? Yes please! Write a letter to the directors of the Lego movie, Chris Miller and Phil Lord. Convince them to make another!</p>	<p><u>Task 6: Pets or Animals</u></p> <p>Report Text. Do you have a favourite pet? Would you like to let the whole world know how awesome they are? Write a non-chronological report on them. Consider appearance, interests and their good attributes.</p>
