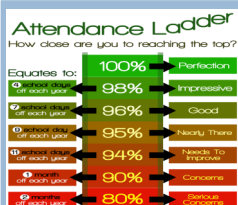

Expected average attendance for a child is 96.1%. Our attendance for last week was:

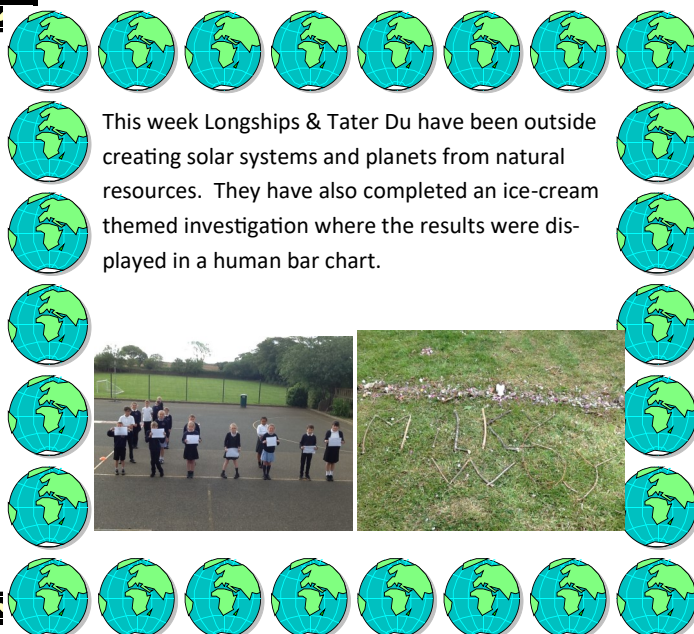
Gribben: 89.11% Trevose: 95.45% Wolfrock: 89.27% Tater Du: 95.22% Longships: 91.2%
