Tuesday 14 th April	Use adjectives to describe the character. Using the picture of the robot, think about what he might be like. Can you write 3 sentences to describe him? Wednesday 15 th April	What can it do? Write at least 5 sentences to explain what the robot might do. e.g. The blue robot likes to roll around my house on the wheels that he has for legs.
