I am sure that as a parent, given the many physical, mental and social benefits of physical activity you are as keen as we are that your child participates in as much exercise as possible. In order to encourage this participation we strive for an 'All Change' policy within PE. This policy means that **ALL students should bring their PE kit even if they are not going to be actively involved as a performer**. They may be given another role such as refereeing, umpiring, scoring, coaching or helping to organise resources. In addition, this policy will prevent school uniform from getting wet/dirty/damaged or pupils getting cold whilst the groups are outside, but ultimately and most importantly, it increases the amount of physical activity that your child will undertake.

Throughout the year, pupils will get to participate in a wide range of activities within PE. This is to ensure that your child has access to a broad and balanced curriculum to help them develop active, healthy lifestyles. Alongside this, teachers and support staff run a variety of clubs to further engage pupils in an active lifestyle.

Last academic year (2016-2017) we had many successes within the school and took part in a range of sports, which we hope will continue into this year.
