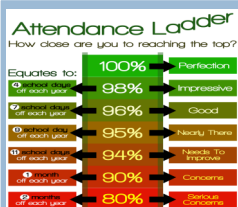

Our topic this term in Tater Du class is the Rampaging Romans! In Geography, we will be looking at where Italy and in particular Rome is, what it is like to holiday there, and how it compares to England. In History, we will be learning about the founding of Rome, what Roman society and life were like, who the gladiators, gods and goddesses were, and what the Romans did for us in Great Britain. We will also be looking at Roman mythology and Roman mosaics. Our Science topic is all about forces, friction and magnetic attraction, and in Music this half term we will be using the Charanga resources to practise our singing and composing skills around Bob Marley's song Three Little Birds. We are planning to go to Truro Museum to enhance our learning about the Romans. We are all looking forward to a fun-packed and industrious half term!

WOLF ROCK CLASS NEWS

This half term, Wolf Rock will take on a fascinating journey, back in time, as they find out about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England and how England became a unified country.
