## **Basis of allocation**

Allocations for the academic year 2016/17 are calculated using the number of pupils in Years 1 to 6, and those age 5 in Year R, as recorded on January 2016 Census (referred to as "eligible pupils" below), as follows:

• Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £8,000 plus £5 per eligible pupil.
