Rocket Seed Experiment- travelled all the way from Space!



This week in Caerhays and Poldark class the children have been involved in a very exciting science experiment. At 04:26am on Tuesday 2nd March, Commander Scott Kelly of NASA and Russian cosmonauts Mikhail Kornienko and Sergey Volkov of Roscosmos landed safely back on Earth in Kazakhstan with some seeds. The seeds then travelled with Scott Kelly to NASA in Houston on a charter flight from Moscow, Russia and returned to the UK on Thursday. We have received our seeds and the children have been working with their buddy to plant them. The children have planted two sets of seeds, one set have not been in space and one has. The experiment is to see if the seeds will grow in the same way as normal seeds. We will be tracking the growth over the next few weeks. We will keep you updated about this.
