We have been given the following advice from **Public Health England** and thought it would be useful to share with you:

Norovirus is generally a mild infection and people usually recover between 2-3 days. No specific treatment is needed, but it is important to keep hydrated by drinking fluids as tolerated. Norovirus is highly infectious and spreads easily from person to person, especially in close knit communities like nurseries and childminders, therefore we are asking for your help to prevent further illness within the school by following the advice in the checklist below:

- Staff and children who develop symptoms of diarrhoea and/or vomiting should stay away from childcare settings until they have been symptom free for at least 48 hours.
- Good hygiene is important to stop the spread of infection, especially hand washing, frequently and thoroughly with warm, soapy water, particularly after using the toilet and before eating and handling food.
- Good hygiene in the home will also help prevent spread to other family members. If
 possible separate toilets and towels should be used. Toilets, including seats and
 handles, as well as door handles, basins and other frequently touched surfaces should
 be cleaned and disinfected frequently.
- If symptoms do not resolve after 48 hours, or if you are concerned please contact your GP by phone or contact the NHS non-emergency number 111.
